The Dondi Project is an effort toward this goal.

We will raise \$1 million over the next year to fund the rebuilding of the **Lutamo School at Dondi**, which was destroyed during years of civil war.

How it all began

Canadian missionaries started the Lutamo School at Dondi in 1914. The school trained generations of leaders—doctors, teachers, social workers, and ministers. In 1975, a civil war erupted in Angola, resulting in:

- the closing of the Lutamo school
- 500,000 dead
- thousands of refugees
- the destruction of infrastructure
- the physical and psychological maiming of thousands

Now a time of peace has begun, and the economy is stabilizing. Education is vital to Angola's future: 50% of the population is under age 16.
